Buckland Construction creates custom designs for each individual client. Dennis and Linda personally oversee the construction of every home. They maintain close, regular communication with clients and have processes in place to help clients stay within their budget from the design phase until the home is completed.

“We help clients prioritize by talking to them about which upgrades would be nice to have and which ones will impact the resale of their house,” Linda says. “Then they can meld that with what they want personally. We track all changes for them and email updates to them periodically so they always know exactly where they stand.”

On average the couple takes on five to 10 projects per year, with home prices starting at \$250,000. They also do remodeling projects.
